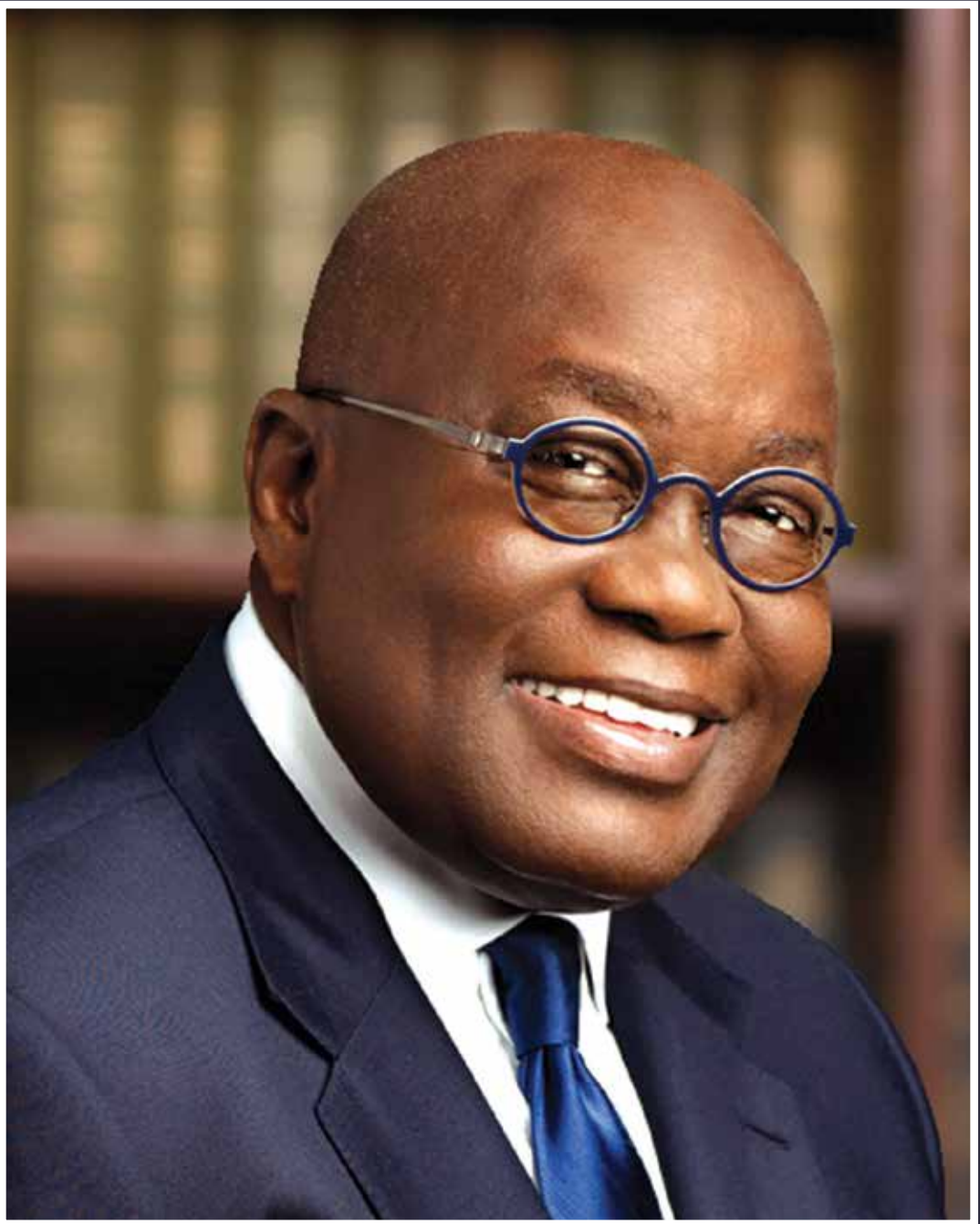

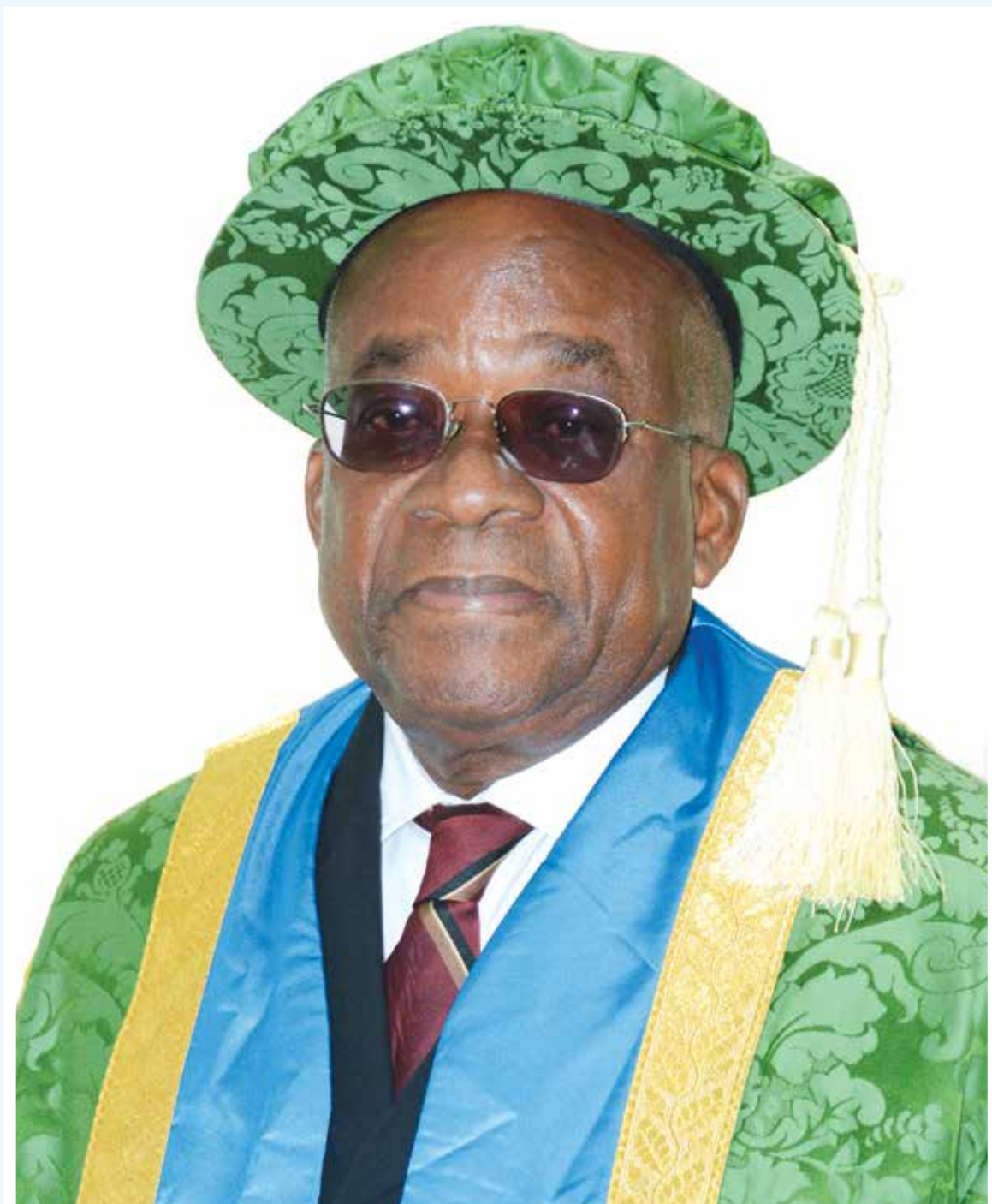

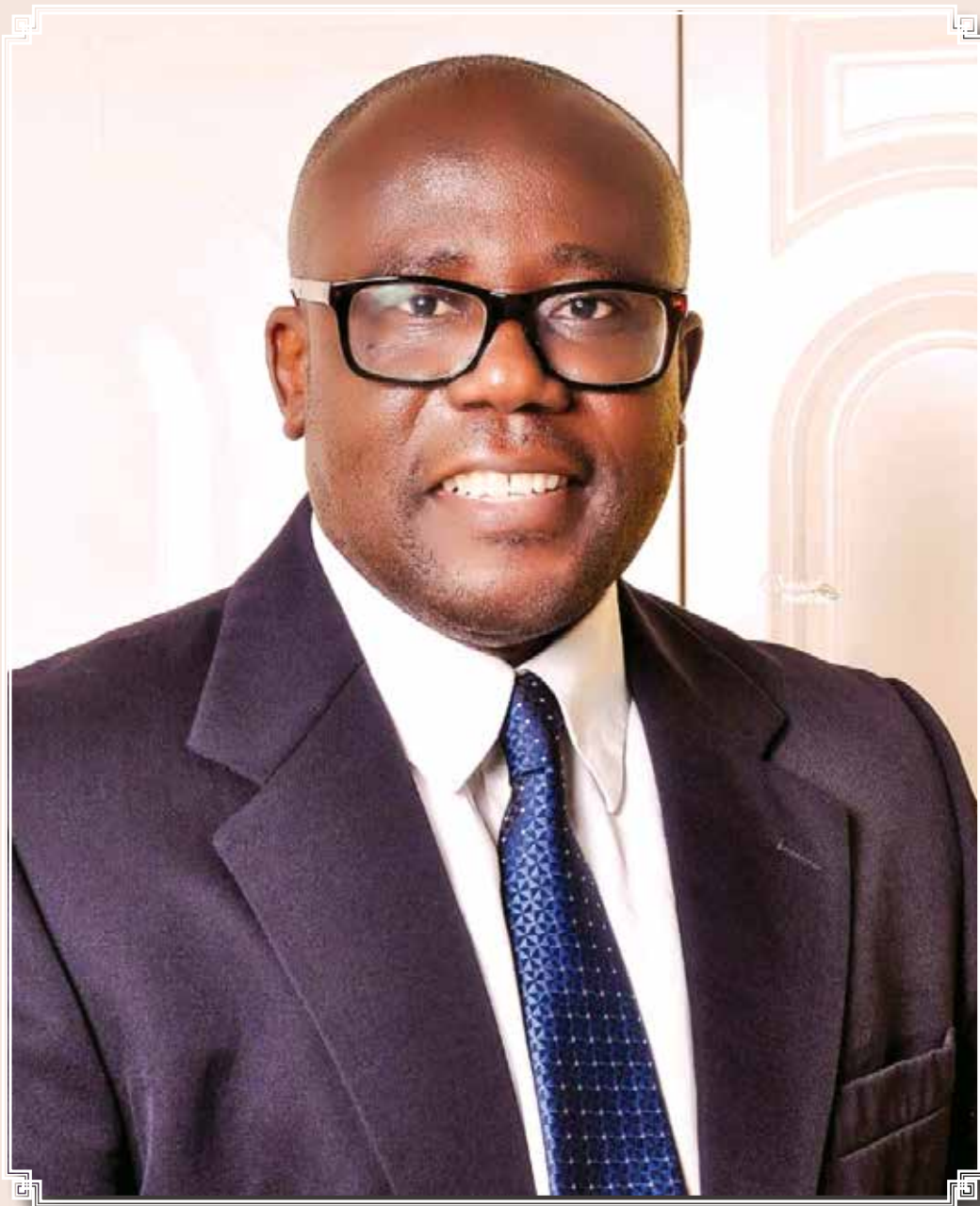

Rev. Albert Ocran is a Management Consultant, Minister and Executive Coach. He is the Lead Consultant of Legacy & Legacy, Co-founder of the Springboard Road Show Foundation and Senior Pastor of ICGC The New Wine Temple.

As a corporate trainer and executive coach, he works with a plethora of local and multinational clients spanning the mining, banking, telecommunications, insurance, petrochemical, educational, manufacturing and not-for-profit sectors.

Albert Ocran was voted by his peers as Ghana's 7th Most Respected CEO for 2009. He also received the Millennium Excellence Award for Motivation in 2010. He has been named for four consecutive years in the list of 100 most influential Ghanaians by eTV Ghana. In 2018, he received an award in the Mentorship Category in the Exclusive Man of the year Africa Awards.

Rev. Ocran is a board member and fel-

low of the Africa Leadership Initiative, West Africa (ALIWA) and the prestigious Aspen Global Leaders Network based in Colorado, USA. His educational media outreaches include Springboard, your virtual university hosted on Joy FM, Joy Prime TV and diverse online platforms. Together with Comfort, he has published 26 bestselling leadership and self-development books.

Albert and Comfort Ocran travel across Ghana annually with the Springboard Road Show, a series of personal development conferences that has mentored over 300 thousand emerging leaders in-person across Ghana over the past 16 years and over 5 million others through online platforms.

In 2020, Springboard executed the CoRe Programme in partnership with Mastercard Foundation that equipped over 23 million young Ghanaians with resilience to cope with the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. In June 2021, the Foundation initiated the Springboard Youth Dialogues, a youth entrepreneurship inter-



vention platform for direct interaction between policy makers and Ghana's teeming youth across the various region. The Foundation is currently implementing the Ghana Grows Programme

PROFILE OF GIMPA

The Ghana Institute of Management and Public Administration (GIMPA) was established in 1961 as a joint Ghana government/United Nations Special Fund Project as the Institute of Public Administration (IPA) to develop the public administrative systems and to produce civil servants with the administrative and professional competence to plan and administer national, regional, and local services.

Over the past years, GIMPA's activities have been guided by five successive mandates from the first Legislative Instrument of 1961 to the current GIMPA Act 2004 (Act 676). Each one of them has affirmed the vision of the founders to be a leading national and international Management Development Institute. The mandates progressively expanded the Institute's scope of business to reflect the manpower needs relevant to national development.

The GIMPA Act of 2004 (Act 676) estab-

lished GIMPA as a Chartered Public Tertiary Institute with a mandate to award certificates, diplomas and degrees up to PhD. level. GIMPA now offers education, training and services in the fields of leadership, management, public administration, technology, law and other humanities disciplines for the public sector, private sector and NGOs.

GIMPA operates under a Governing Council appointed by the President of the Republic of Ghana in accordance with Article 70 of the 1992 Constitution.

- Business School
- School of Technology
- School of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences
- School of Graduate Studies and Research
- Faculty of Law

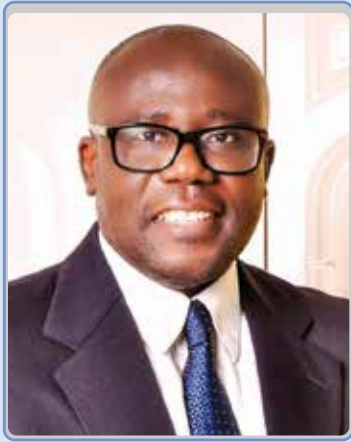

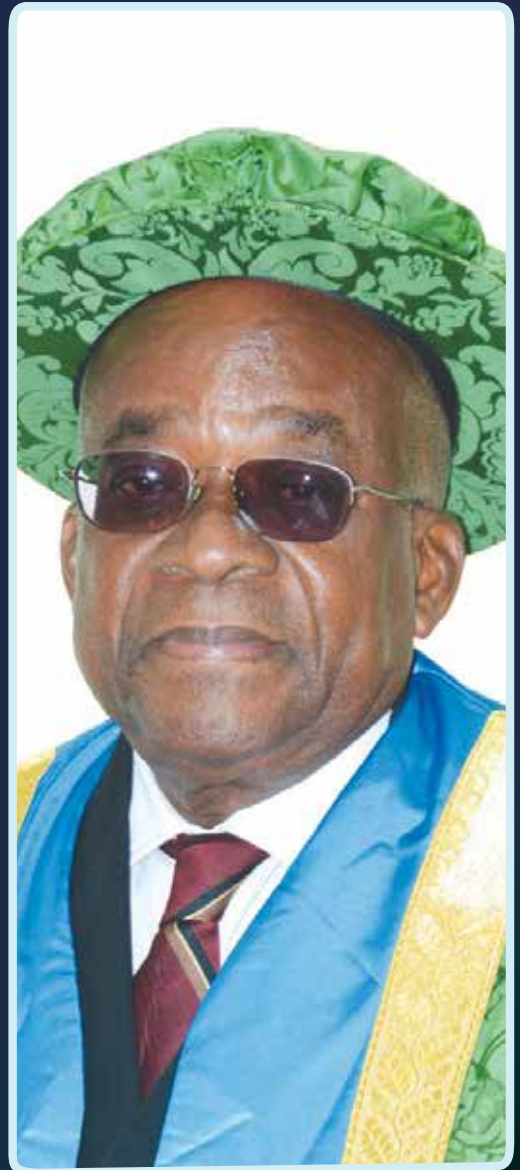

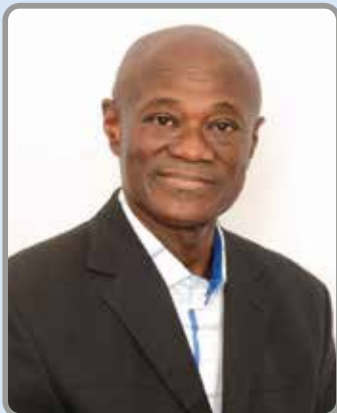
