














A Year of Gratitude and Optimism

## Faculty Spotlight

Prof Lord Mawuko-Yevugah is internationally recognized expert in International Relations and foreign policy analysis. He is currently the coordinator of the masters in International Relations and Diplomacy program at the School of Public Service and Governance, having previously served as the Head of Department of International Relations and Public Management. He is also the Institute's Affiliate Coordinator for the Kofi Annan International Peacekeeping and Training Centre (KAIPTC). He is also the Convener and Patron of International Relations and Diplomacy Network Ghana (IRDNGhana).

Educated at the prestigious University of Cambridge as a Commonwealth Scholar, Prof Lord Mawuko-Yevugah has held various research fellowships including the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences Research Fellowship, Geneva Graduate Institute of International Relations and Development Global South Research Fellowship, and American Society for Public Administration (ASPA) Young Scholars Fellowship.

In October 2024, Prof Mawuko-Yevugah was invited to the Wageningen University in The Netherlands, as an International Research Partner to participate in the Inception Workshop of the seed money project on "Towards Just Sustainability Transformation across the North and the South: Addressing Externalisation Effects of the European Union Green Deal in the Global South"

He was part of a team of researchers nominated by the African Union and funded by the Government of China in 2018 to develop the policy framework and the implementation strategy of Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (Africa CDC).

In 2021, Prof. Mawuko-Yevugah together with a global network of collaborators led by Professor Bonny Ibhawoh of McMaster University in Canada was awarded CAD \$2.5million by the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada (SSHRC) for the Participedia Phase 2 project on the theme, "Strengthening Democracy by Mobilizing Knowledge of Democratic Innovation".

Prof. Mawuko-Yevugah has published widely in the areas of international political economy of aid and international development cooperation; comparative politics of development in Africa; political economy of Ghana; and postcolonial theory. He is the author of a number of books including, Made in Chana: Reflections on Governance and Power Shifts (University of Ghana Press, 2018); Reinventing Development: Aid Reform and Technologies of Governance in Ghana (Routledge, 2016); African Youth Cultures in a Globalized World (Ashgate, 2015).
