GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Master's degree in any discipline with a CGPA of 3.0 (or its equivalent as determined by GIMPA) from an accredited university.
- **Other requirements**
 - A minimum of five (5) years post-Master's degree qualification senior management experience at General Manager, Head of Department/Division, Director, or CEO/MD level;
 - Application Essay indicating the area of management practice the applicant is interested in as a focus and the rationale for pursuing a DMGT;
 - Two (2) letters of reference (at least one from an employment supervisor);
 - Detailed current Curriculum Vitae (CV); and a
 - Mandatory interview to verify professional experience and suitability for the programme.

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- Applicant must have at least a 2nd Class Lower Bachelor degree from an accredited university. Business School 1-year Master applicants with 3rd Class or Pass Bachelor degree will be interviewed.
- Other requirements:
 - **Master of Science in ICT, IT & Law and Digital Forensics:** Applicant must have a Bachelor degree in an IT or Computer Science related field. Applicant with Third Class or Pass must first take GIMPA's Postgraduate Diploma in ICT programme.
- **Master of Laws:** Applicant must have a Bachelor of Laws degree.
- Chartered Professional qualifications such as ACCA, ICA, ICOSA, GIPS, CIB, plus three years' post-qualification experience. Equivalencies of Professional certificates should be determined by the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission (GTEC).
- Other Foreign Qualifications should be sent to Ghana Tertiary Education Council (GTEC) for the establishment of their equivalencies, to determine their eligibility for admission to tertiary education in Ghana.

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES**➤ WASSCE/SSCE/GBCE Candidates:**

Credit Passes (A1-C6) or (A-D) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects, including English language and Mathematics, plus three (3) relevant elective subjects. Physics or Elective Mathematics (**Grade D or C6**) is required to pursue Computer Science.

➤ GCE "A" Level Candidates:

Passes in three (3) GCE "A" Level subjects (at least one of the passes should be Grade "D" or better) plus five (5) GCE "O" Level credit passes (Grades 1-6) including English Language and Mathematics. Physics or Elective Mathematics (**Grade D or C6**) is required to pursue Computer Science.

➤ Higher National Diploma (Top-Up) Applicants

- Admission of Higher National Diploma (HND) candidates to first degree programmes to either Level 200 or 300 depending on the relativeness of programmes.
- Applicants must have graduated with a good HND certificate (at least second-class lower division). Other diploma qualifications from elsewhere assessed to be equivalent to HND by the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission (GTEC) may be similarly considered.

➤ Advanced Business Certificate Examination (ABCE) Applicants

- Full Diploma in ABCE.
- Credit Passes (WASSCE: A1-C6) or (SSSCE/GBCE: A-D) in five (5) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects, including English language and Mathematics, plus two (2) relevant elective subjects. Physics or Elective Mathematics (**Grade D or C6**) is required to pursue Computer Science.
- ABCE applicants may be considered at Level 200 of a degree programme.

➤ Professional and Other Qualifications

Professional certificates should be sent to Ghana Tertiary Education Council (GTEC) for the establishment of their equivalencies, to determine their eligibilities for admission to tertiary institutions.

➤ Foreign Qualifications

Foreign Qualifications should be sent to Ghana Tertiary Education Council (GTEC) for the establishment of their equivalencies, to determine their eligibilities for admission to tertiary institutions in Ghana.

➤ Diploma in Business Studies (DBS)

Applicants with DBS should have four (4) WASSCE passes (A1-C6) including Mathematics and English or four (4) SSSCE passes (A-D) in addition to the DBS to qualify for admission.

➤ Mature Applicants

Applicants can also apply through GIMPA's Mature Programme. Mature applicants must:

- Be at least 25 years of age at the time of application;
 - Have completed SSS/SHS or taken an equivalent programme;
 - Possess a proof of age (passport, baptismal card, birth certificate etc.) issued not less than 5 years from application date;
 - Complete the undergraduate application form;
 - Have taken and passed the GIMPA Mature Programme
- Upon passing the Mature programme, applicants are directly enrolled on the chosen Bachelor Degree programme.

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

➤ WASSCE/SSCE/ Candidates:

Credit Passes (WASSCE: A1-D7) or (SSSCE/GBCE: A-D) in five (5) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects, including English language and Mathematics, plus two (2) relevant elective subjects.
